

3 Simple Rules:

1. Move only one square at a time.
2. Cannot put a larger square on top of smaller.
3. Cannot move a stack of squares at once to another pin.

Shows how to solve in 31 moves

The chart below shows placing a square on a pin

Place board so Pin 1 is on the left

Put all squares on Pin 1

For Move 1 you are moving Square A the to Pin 3
